We highly recommend that every puppy is spayed or neutered at 6 months of age to avoid health and behavioral complications. At Pampered Paws, we treat our patients like tiny humans, so your puppy will be in our nurses' arms from the time they arrive until they're back in yours.

Anti-Parasites

Heartworm

Is a disease transmitted by mosquito bites. It is critical that every puppy be given a heartworm preventative once a month for life.

Preventative Options:

- Proheart 6: (Injection) Heartworms, Hookworms. Good for 6 months!
- Heartgard (meaty chew): Heartworms, Hookworms, Roundworms
- Interceptor (Flavored Tablet) Heartworms, roundworms, hookworms, whipworms and tapeworms

Did You Know?

Heartworms are the biggest killer of dogs in Mississippi. That's why it's so important to keep your dog on monthly preventative: it's the only way to protect them.

Fleas & Ticks

In addition to heartworm preventative, your puppy needs a monthly flea and tick preventative. Though these products help repel ticks, they won't kill them on contact, so if you find a tick on your puppy, it's best to remove it immediately.

Preventative Options

- Nexgard(Oral): Fleas, ticks lice. Doesn't wash off Dr. Wellman's favorite
- Advantix (topical): Fleas, ticks, mosquitoes, biting flies, lice, but toxic to cats.





Did You Know?

6 months is the ideal age to spay or neuter your puppy. Spaying and neutering prevents many different types of health issues and cancers, and can reduce many undesirable behaviors.

- The perfect size crate should allow your puppy to stand up, sit, turn around, and lie down. Puppies should always have access to water, so make sure you can fit a bowl inside, too.
- Keep your puppy away from rope toys, air fresheners, socks, kitty litter, cords, medication containers, coins, and toys with small pieces.
- Puppies should eat puppy food until they are a year old.
- Please purchase an ID tag from PetSmart or Hollywood Feed as soon as possible, and attach it to your dog's collar.
- Remember: a tired puppy is a happy puppy. Take your puppy on lots of walks. We like to say that walks are to dogs as flying is to birds!
